Relay's Tiered Discounted Tuition Model

Financial Aid Options

Federal Financial Aid

In order to receive federal financial aid or need-based financial aid, prospective students must fill out the FAFSA form. The FAFSA form can be found [here](#). Student Financial Services (SFS) reviews FAFSA applications on a rolling basis. Relay's school code is 042086.

Institutional Scholarships

Institutional aid at Relay may include scholarships awarded based on need and can vary in amounts and availability by academic year. These annual awards are released in three even disbursements, at the start of the summer, fall, and spring terms. Students must be enrolled at least half-time to receive need-based aid. Students with the greatest financial need will be given priority for institutional aid.

AmeriCorps / AmeriCorps

Students can earn the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award to offset out-of-pocket Relay tuition expenses. AmeriCorps members may be eligible for other benefits such as loan forbearance and interest interestaccrual payments.

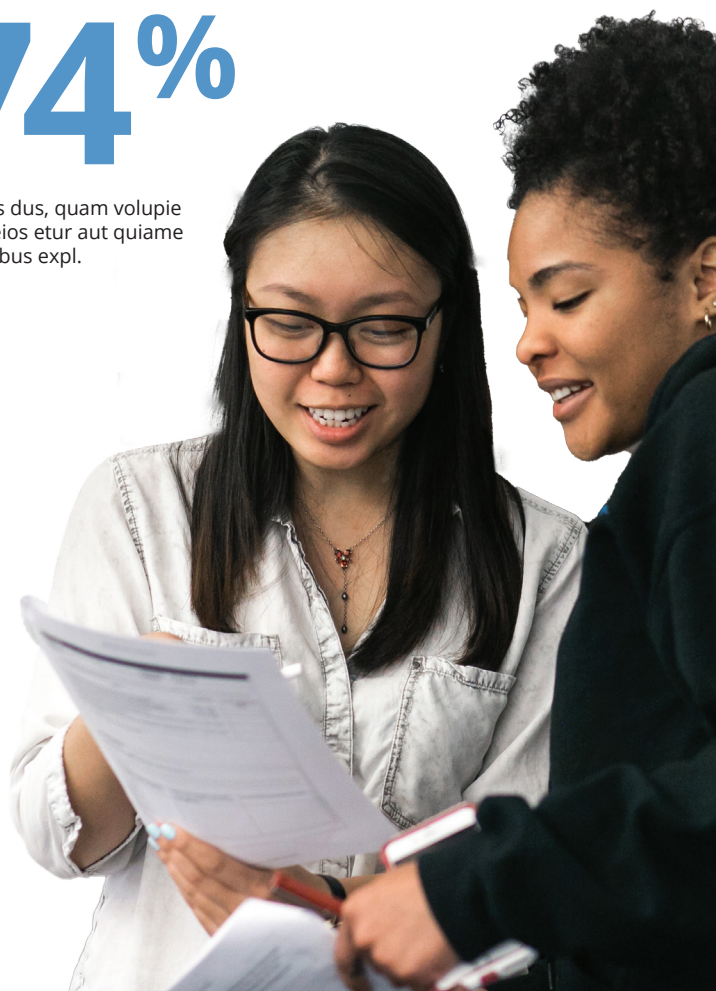
Participants in AmeriCorps earned education awards up to \$7,395 during academic year 2024-25. Awards are earned upon successful completion of a year of service and may be used for eligible educational expenses or toward their education loans.
